

12 Hrs: The community of Midpines has minimal threat potential and is still under an evacuation advisory. Various roads between Mariposa and Midpines are under an evacuation order.
 24 Hrs: Damaged 70kv transmission lines have left Yosemite Valley and El Portal on intermittent generator power. The sole source watershed for 2,000 Mariposa residents is being compromised.
