CAL FIRE RESCINDS RESIDENTIAL BURN SUSPENSION FOR HUMBOLDT, DEL NORTE and WESTERN TRINITY COUNTIES

Fortuna – Due to recent rainfall, The California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection (CAL FIRE) is cancelling the proclamation suspending burning on State Responsibility lands in Humboldt, Del Norte and western Trinity Counties.

CAL FIRE Unit Chief Ralph Minnich is formally cancelling the suspension and advises that people possessing current and valid “Non-standard” agricultural and “Residential” burn permits can now resume burning on permissible burn days. Safe “Residential” burning still requires a minimum of 10’ clearance around the 4’ piles and an adult must be in attendance at all times.

Chief Minnich hopes that people will continue their work towards clearing the flammable vegetation around their residences to create a defensible space from wildfire.

All people wishing to burn are required to obtain “Non-standard” agricultural and “Residential” burning permits from the North Coast Unified Air Quality Management District (NCUAQMD). They can be contacted at (707) 443-3093.
