

PROCLAMATION RESCINDING THE SUSPENSION OF BURN PERMITS

In the

**Shasta - Trinity Unit, of the California Department of
Forestry & Fire Protection**

WHICH INCLUDES ALL STATE RESPONSIBILITY AREAS WITHIN THE COUNTIES OF: SHASTA AND EASTERN TRINITY

Due changes in weather and recent rainfall, the seasonal menace of wildfires and their potential to destroy life and property, and utilizing the authority vested in me by Section 4423.1 of the Public Resources Code, I hereby proclaim that all RESIDENTIAL BURN SUSPENSION within the State Responsibility Areas in the counties listed above will be RESCINDED beginning 8:00 a.m., Monday, October 25th, 2010.

Burn permits will be required for dooryard burning until October 31, 2010. After November 1st, lands in Shasta County Fire Department jurisdiction do not require a permit for dooryard burning.

Agricultural, training, campfire permits, and vegetation control burns conducted under permit are not affected by this Proclamation.

This PROCLAMATION is therefore issued at Redding, California, on the 25th day of October, 2010.
