## TERMINATION OF PROCLAMATION SUSPENDING BURNING PERMITS AND OTHER USES OF OPEN FIRE

Due to the significant amount of rain that Siskiyou County received this weekend along with a general improvement in predicted fire weather conditions, my proclamation suspending burning under permit and other uses of open fire pursuant to the provisions of sections 4423.1, 4423.3, and 4423.4 of the Public Resources Code, that became effective at 0800 hours on Thursday, July 1, 2010 is hereby terminated, effective at 0800 hours on Monday October 25, 2010.

Those areas where the burning permit suspension is terminated by this proclamation are:

1. State Responsibility Lands within the County of Siskiyou
